The construction of these two classrooms at Bilton High School were a result of a surplus from the grant for the construction of the original structures - 5 classrooms, 10 EnviroLoos, Fencing, and an Administration Block.

The construction of two classrooms is well underway. The project is at roof-level; the site inspection for the second phase of the building was conducted and approved by all members of the Project Committee responsible for this project.

We experienced delays due to supplier logistical issues which have subsequently been resolved. The builder is currently busy with roofing. The plan is to complete the project by the end of July. We look forward to keeping you apprised on these developments.
